Aaniin. The Chief Executive is seeking two nominees to serve on the Corporate Commission Board. A term ending March 31, 2030, for both the District I Board member and District II Board member. The Board assists the Corporate Commission in exercising a more effective form of commerce, making sound business and economic development decisions, and operating commercial enterprises for the benefit of the Band.

Board members must be at least 18 years old, and will be selected based on relevant training, experience, and other qualifications. Board members must attend monthly and special meetings, and will be compensated. Importantly, Board members must be willing to learn applicable laws and regulations (Title 16, Chapter 2, of Mille Lacs Band Statutes), available on the Band's Tribal Register.
