Band Assembly Meeting

May 1, 2024

The Speaker Pro Tempore of the Assembly continued the meeting of the Band Assembly from Friday, March 22, 2024. The District Representatives amended and approved the agenda.

The District Representatives took from the table and denied a contract for R & R Landscaping and Construction to provide labor and materials for a renovation project at a private elder home in District I. (Per the request of Executive Branch)

The District Representatives took from the table and approved Amendment to the Rules of Procedure for Band Assembly.

The District Representatives tabled Band Assembly Bill 21-01-29-24 (A Bill Authorizing a Supplemental Appropriation for the purpose of authorizing expenditures and budget revision(s)/transfer(s) for the Executive Branch for the Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2024).


