Weekly Sync Meeting

December 3, 2024

Legislative staff facilitated a weekly sync meeting with elected officials and staff to review the upcoming Band Assembly agenda. The meeting included bills to work on, the workshop schedule, workshop projects, and District Representative initiatives.

Band Assembly Meeting

December 4, 2024

The Speaker of the Assembly convened a meeting of the Band Assembly. The District Representatives amended and approved the agenda.

The District Representatives approved Band Assembly Record: October 21, 2024.

The District Representatives approved Band Assembly Bill 21-02-69-24 (A Bill for an act amending subchapter 13 of Title 8 to address an inconsistency in language between sections 3151 and 3158).

The District Representatives approved Band Assembly Bill 21-02-70-24 (A bill for an act amending Title 11, chapters 3 and 5 to clarify the definition of a firearm and a silencer and to modify existing firearms restrictions by authorizing the use of silencers for deer hunting and repealing language for revocation or suspension of hunting, fishing, and gathering privileges).

The District Representatives amended and approved Band Assembly Bill 21-02-71-24 (An Act Authorizing a Supplemental Appropriation for the purpose of authorizing expenditures and budget revision(s)/transfer(s) for the Executive and Legislative Branches for the Fiscal Years ending September 30, 2024 and September 30, 2025).

The District Representatives approved Foster Care License: District 3 FFH2230002.

The District Representatives approved Hardship Request: D3-01-11-24.


Secretary-Treasurer Sheldon Boyd has no message.
