An Act amending Title 8, chapter 13, subchapter 1 to modify the definition of “controlled substance” to align with Band law.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BAND ASSEMBLY OF THE NON-REMOVABLE MILLE LACS BAND OF OJIBWE:

Section 1. Amending Title 8, chapter 13, subchapter 1.

§ 3103. Definitions.


- (1) **“Controlled Substance”** is any drug or chemical whose manufacture, possession, or use is prohibited by Band law ~~regulated by the federal government as defined by the FDA. A Controlled Substance Analog is a chemical or drug whose chemical makeup is substantially similar to a controlled substance as defined in 21 U.S.C. § 813.~~

EFFECTIVE DATE. This bill shall take effect immediately upon signature by the Chief Executive, or lack of a veto, as provided in 3 MLBS § 17.
