

**Act 64-22**

An Act of Supplemental Appropriation for the purpose of authorizing expenditures and budget transfer/revision for the Legislative Branch for the Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2022. This bill has been drafted based on formal documents submitted by the Legislative Affairs Director on July 21, 2022 and the District I Representative on July 22, 2022.

The District II Representative introduced the following Bill on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2022.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE BAND ASSEMBLY OF THE NON-REMOVABLE MILLE LACS BAND OF OJIBWE:**

**Section 1: Governmental operations.** The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes expenditures for the Legislative Branch for the Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2022.

**Section 1.01: Appropriation and authorizations of expenditures.** The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes the expenditures of supplemental programmatic funds for the following:

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**Section 1.02: Budget revision/transfers.** The Band Assembly hereby authorizes the budget revision(s)/transfer(s) of programmatic funds for the following:

**FY2022 Legislative:** a budget revision to move monies within the DOJ CTAS Statute Revision Grant budget to allow for the printing of the updated/revised statute books, increase remote workability for Revision staff as well as properly align fringe benefits with our Revision staff as submitted (Memo from Legislative Affairs Director dated July 7, 2022):

DOJ CTAS Statute Revision Grant 101-1430-1 \$76,989.93 – **Total**

**Section 1.03: Grant funds.** All funds appropriated for federal, state and private grant funds shall be appropriated to align with the grant term so as to automatically carry-over to the next Fiscal Year if appropriated funds remain and if the grant is not completed within Fiscal Year 2022. If,

for any reason, the grant term runs over the original end date causing costs to exceed the original appropriated amount, the Band Assembly must be notified immediately so as to take appropriate action. In addition, Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes the expenditure of all federal, state and private grant funds only after receipt by Band Assembly, of signed award letter from grantor agency.

**Section 1.04: Purposes of expenditures.** All funds appropriated are maximum fund amounts and shall not be exceeded. Funds must be utilized for the purposes for which they were requested, notwithstanding any other active Band Ordinance.


