

Band Assembly Bill 05-01-08-92

A bill of tribal government establishing a salary structure for the Chief Executive, Secretary-Treasurer and District Representatives.

The District II Representative introduced the following bill on the 29th day of April, 1992

Preamble

Be it enacted by the Band Assembly for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians for the purpose of establishing a salary structure for the Chief Executive, Secretary-Treasurer, and District Representatives. Band Statute 1007-MLC-14, Section 6, is hereby repealed and replaced by this enactment.

Chapter 14

Section 6. Elected Official Compensation. The Chief Executive, Secretary-Treasurer, and District Representatives shall be compensated for their services as set forth below. District Representatives shall be compensated according to Line 1. The Chief Executive and Secretary-Treasurer shall be compensated according to Line 2. Elected officials shall be paid based upon their cumulative number of years holding elected office, whether as Chief Executive, Secretary-Treasurer, or District Representative.
