

ORDINANCE 13 - 94

An ordinance of supplemental appropriation for the governmental operations of the Executive Branch of tribal government for fiscal year 1994.

The District II Representative introduced the following bill on the 11th day of March, 1994.

Preamble

It is enacted by the Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians for the purpose of supplemental appropriation for governmental operations for fiscal year 1994.

Chapter 78

Section 1: Governmental Operations. The Band Assembly hereby appropriates supplemental programmatic funds for the Education Administration, Court of Central Jurisdiction and the Public Works Department.

Section 1.01: Amendment to Section 1.02. The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes the supplemental appropriation of thirty nine thousand dollars and no cents (\$ 39,000.00) for the Education Administration; three thousand four hundred three dollars and no cents (\$ 3,403.00) for the Court of Central Jurisdiction and five thousand nine hundred fifty dollars and no cents (\$ 5,950.00) for the Public Works Department. Which amends the total to read twenty one million forty thousand six hundred forty two dollars and fifty eight cents (\$ 21,040,642.58).

Section 1.02: Amendment to Section 1.03. The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes the supplemental expenditure of programmatic funds for the following:
