### Ordinance 38-98

An ordinance of Tribal Government amending the compensation structure for the Chief Executive, Secretary-Treasurer and District Representatives.

The District \_II\_ Representative introduced the following bill on the \_24th\_ day of June 1998.

#### Preamble

It is enacted by the Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for the purpose of amending the compensation structure for the Chief Executive, Secretary-Treasurer and District Representatives of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe.

### Title 26

### Section 1. Amendment.

26 MLBSA § 6 is hereby amended by this Act.

### Section 2. Effective Date.

Effective upon the taking the oath of office and commencing at 12:01 a.m. on that date the Chief Executive of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, the Secretary/Treasurer and the District Representatives of the Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe shall be compensated for their services pursuant to this Act.

### Section 3. Benefits.

Elected officials of the Band shall become eligible for the Band's benefit package, at the time prescribed in § 2 of this Act.

# Section 4. Compensation.

- (a) the compensation for Elected Officials shall be based on an annual salary prescribed by Band statute; and
  - (A) the salary for Elected Officials does not include benefits received as a result of being enrolled in any of the Mille Lacs Band's benefit programs;
- (b) only years seated in an elected office, regardless of position, shall be used in determining the number of years in service.

## Section 5. End of Term (Severance).

- (a) After an Elected Official is no longer seated as an Elected Official he/she or their designated beneficiary, as the case may be, shall be paid 80% of their last salary rate and retain all of their insurance coverage and policies as if still in office for a period of (6) months, less any deductions that may be lawfully required. Any existing benefits or policies may not be expanded after an officials term.
- (b) If an elected official is removed from office pursuant to 3 MLBSA § 25, he/she shall not be eligible to receive compensation pursuant to this section.

### Section 6. Annual Leave.

If an Elected Official is unable to use their annual leave or any part thereof in a given fiscal year they may be paid for the remaining balance, less any deductions that may be lawfully required.

### Section 7. Sick Leave.

An Elected Official may donate their sick leave or any part thereof in a given fiscal year to any individuals employed by the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe who need additional sick leave because of illness or injury.

### Section 8. Merit Raises.

The Elected Officials shall receive annual increases based on the number of years of service.

## Section 9. Definitions.

(a) Elected Officials. For purposes of this Act an Elected Official shall be the Chief Executive, the Secretary/Treasurer, and the District Representatives of the Band Assembly.
