

Ordinance 32-98

An ordinance of supplemental appropriation for the Corporate Commission of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe.

The District III Representative introduced the following bill on the 20th day of May 1998.

Preamble

It is enacted by the Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for the purpose of appropriating for governmental operation for fiscal year ending September 30, 1998.

Chapter 78

Section 1: For the purpose of administration and economic development for the Corporate Commission for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1998.

Section 1.01: Amendment to Section 1.02. The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes the expenditures of Five million two hundred eighty-six thousand four hundred thirty-three dollars and no cents (\$5,078,011.00) a supplemental appropriation, under **Corporate Commission**, which amends the **total Tribal Operations** to read Fifty-eight million, two hundred forty-six thousand, three hundred twenty-six dollars and sixty-three cents (\$58,246,356.63).

Section 1.02: Amendment to Section 1.03. The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes the supplemental expenditure of programmatic funds for the following:
