Ordinance 16-01

An ordinance of Tribal Government to provide for the amendment to Band Statute 1090-MLC-47 of the Laws of the Non-Removable Mille Lacs Bands of Ojibwe Indians.

The District I Representative introduced the following bill on the 14th day of February 2001.

Preamble

It is enacted by the Band Assembly of the Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians for the purpose of amending Band Statute 1090-MLC-47.

Title II

- Section 1. Section 2 and 2.01 of Band Statute 1090-MLC –47 are hereby repealed and replaced with the following
- Section 2. Section 2. Authority. Under this Title the Secretary/Treasurer of the Mille Lacs Band shall exercise the authority of the Mille Lacs Band, to withhold any funds that may be payable to any person, for use as a set-off against any debt or court ordered fine owed by that person to the Mille Lacs Band, except for distribution of funds received by the Band for attorney fees from Mille Lacs v. State of Minnesota and the Nelson Act Claims Settlement.
- Section 2.01 Section 2.01. The Secretary/Treasurer shall withhold any funds payable to individuals only if the debt or fine owed is delinquent by 45 days or more, except as otherwise provided in Section 2.
