Ordinance 18-01

An ordinance of supplemental appropriation and fiscal year carryover and budget modification for Administration, Community Development, Education, Health and Human Services and Natural Resources of the Executive Branch of Tribal Government for Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2001.

A Bill of supplemental appropriation for Education of the Executive Branch for fiscal year ending September 30, 2000.

The District II Representative introduced the following Bill on the 20th day of March 2001.

Preamble

It is enacted by the Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for the purpose of appropriating for governmental operation for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2001.

Title I.

Section 1: Band Assembly Bill 09-03-17-01 is hereby repealed.

Section 2: Governmental Operations. The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes expenditures for Administration, Community Development, Education, Health and Human Services, Natural Resources, and Public Safety for fiscal year ending September 30, 2000 and September 30, 2001.

Fourteen thousand seventy-nine dollars and seventy-six cents (\$14,079.76) for FY00 State Head Start FY00 clean-up [201-351], Thirty thousand dollars and no cents (\$30,000.00) for NASS Nutrition Program (324), Sixty-three thousand eight hundred forty-two dollars and eighty-six cents (\$63,842.86) for NASS O&M (210-325), under **Education**; which amends the **Total Fiscal Year 2000 Tribal Operations** to read Sixty-four million five hundred six thousand five hundred forty-six dollars and twelve cents (\$64,506,546.12).

Section 2.03: The Band Assembly hereby authorizes Commissioners to approve budgetary transfers within programs <u>up</u> to \$10,000.00 provided that the transfers are allowable under grant provisions, if applicable and that sufficient funds are available for the transfer. For transfers <u>over</u> \$10,000.00, the Band Assembly hereby authorizes the Administration Policy Board to approve budget transfers within programs of <u>up</u> to 50% of the total programs budget within a given budget line if the program is <u>under</u> \$100,000.00 and <u>up</u> to 20% if the program is \$100,000.00 or greater.

All funds appropriated are maximum fund amounts and shall not be exceeded.

Section 2.04 All funds appropriated for construction projects, shall be automatically carried-over to the next fiscal year, if total amount appropriated is unspent.
