Ordinance 29-06

An Ordinance of Supplemental Appropriation from Economic Development for Hinckley Routine Maintenance Garage for Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2006.

The District II Representative introduced the following Bill on the 20th day of April 2006.

Preamble

It is enacted by the Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for the purpose of appropriating for Economic development for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2006.

Title I

Section 1: Economic Development. The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes expenditures from Economic Development for fiscal year ending September 30, 2006.

Section 1.01: Amendment to Section 1.02. The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes the expenditures of: Two million seventy thousand dollars and no cents (\$2,070,000.00) for Routine Maintenance Garage, under **Economic Development**, which amends the **Total Fiscal Year 2006 Economic Development** to read Sixteen million nine hundred six thousand six hundred twenty three dollars and no cents (\$16,906,623.00).

Section 1.02: Amendment to Section 1.03. The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes the expenditure of supplemental programmatic funds for the following:

All funds appropriated shall stay within the given budgeted amounts. Economic Development of the Corporate Commission shall update the Band Assembly on a monthly basis and include the Band Assembly in the formal close-out process.

Section 1.04 All funds appropriated for capital construction projects shall be appropriated to align with the project length so as to automatically carry-over to the next fiscal year if appropriated funds remain and if the project is not completed within Fiscal Year 2006. If, for any reason, the project length runs over the contracted period for construction causing construction costs to exceed the appropriated amount, <u>a written</u> Change Order shall immediately be routed to the Band Assembly for appropriate action.
