

Ordinance 37-07

An Ordinance of Budget Transfer for Gaming Regulatory Authority of the Tribal Government for Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2007.

The District III Representative introduced the following Bill on the 24th day of July, 2007.

Preamble

It is enacted by the Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for the purpose of appropriating for governmental operations for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2007.

Title I.

Section 1: Governmental Operations. The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes expenditures for Gaming Regulatory Authority for fiscal year ending September 30, 2007.

Section 1.02.1: The Band Assembly hereby authorizes the transfer of programmatic funds for the following:

100-187 Internal Audit Department amount increased:	\$ 78,705.84


Section 1.03: The Band Assembly hereby authorizes the Executive Director to approve budgetary transfers within programs up to **\$5,000.00**, if sufficient funds are available for the transfer. For transfers over **\$5,000.00**, the Band Assembly hereby must approve such transfers.

All funds appropriated are maximum fund amounts and shall not be exceeded.


