Ordinance 11-07

An Ordinance of Supplemental Appropriation, Budget Transfers and Revisions for Administration, Community Development and Education of the Executive Branch of Tribal Government for fiscal years ending September 30, 2006 and September 30, 2007.

The District III Representative introduced the following Bill on the 21st day of December, 2006.

Preamble

It is enacted by the Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for the purpose of appropriating for governmental operation for the fiscal years ending September 30, 2006 and September 30, 2007.

Title I.

Section 1: Governmental Operations. The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes expenditures for Administration, Community Development, and Education for fiscal years ending September 30, 2006 and September 30, 2007.

Section 1.01: Amendment to Section 1.02. The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes the expenditures of Three thousand two hundred seventy nine dollars and fifty nine cents (\$3,279.59) from part grant and income received, under **Administration**; Forty eight thousand nine hundred dollars and no cents (\$48,900.00) for Johnson O'Malley 201-313, under **Education**; Eighteen thousand fifty three dollars and no cents (\$18,053.00) for MATTS 220-440 of reimbursement, One thousand nine hundred seventy one dollars and no cents (\$1,971.00) for Weatherization Propane State 220-490 new grant, Three hundred thousand three hundred ninety dollars and no cents (\$364,390.00) for IHS Self Governance under **Health and Human Services**; which amends the **Total Fiscal Year 2007 Tribal Operations** to read Ninety two million four hundred eighty two thousand seven hundred eleven dollars and seventy two cents (\$92,482,711.72).

Section 1.02: Amendment to Section 1.03. The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes the expenditure of supplemental programmatic funds for the following:

Section 1.03 The Band Assembly hereby authorizes commissioners to approve budgetary transfers within programs up to \$10,000.00 per line item, provided that the transfers are allowable under grant provisions, if applicable. For transfers over \$10,000.00, the Band Assembly hereby authorizes the Administrative Policy Board to approve budget transfers within programs of up to 50% of the total program budget transfers within a given budget line item if the program is under one hundred thousand dollars and up to 20% if the program is one hundred thousand dollars or greater.

All funds appropriated are maximum fund amounts and shall not be exceeded.
