

Ordinance 22-07

An Ordinance approving a Budget Transfer for Office of Management and Budget of the Legislative Branch of the Tribal Government for Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2007.

The District I Representative introduced the following Bill on the 6th day of March 2007.

Preamble

It is enacted by the Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for the purpose of appropriating for governmental operations for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2007.

Title I.

Section 1: Governmental Operations. The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes expenditures for Office of Management and Budget for fiscal year ending September 30, 2007.

Section 1.02.1: The Band Assembly hereby authorizes the transfer of programmatic funds for the following:

Office of Management and Budget-Budget Transfer


Section 1.03: The Band Assembly hereby authorizes Commissioners to approve budgetary transfers within programs up to \$10,000.00 provided that the transfers are allowable under grant provisions, if applicable and that sufficient funds are available for the transfer. For transfers over \$10,000.00, the Band Assembly hereby authorizes the Administration Policy Board to approve budget transfers within programs of up to 50% of the total programs budget within a given budget line if the program is under \$100,000.00 and up to 20% if the program is **\$100,000.00** or greater.

All funds appropriated are maximum fund amounts and shall not be exceeded.


