Ordinance 50-08

An Ordinance of Supplemental Appropriation for Education, Health and Human Services, Community Development and the Department of Natural Resources of the Tribal Government for Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2007.

The District I Representative introduced the following Bill on the 4th day of October 2007.

Preamble

It is enacted by the Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for the purpose of appropriating for governmental operations for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2007.

Title I

Section 1: Government Operations. The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes expenditures for Education, Health and Human Services, Community Development and the Department of Natural Resources for fiscal year ending September 30, 2007.

Section 1.01: Amendment to Section 1.02. The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes the expenditures of: Ten thousand dollars and no cents (\$10,000.00) for American Indian Parent Family grant 201-327, two thousand seven hundred fifty seven dollars and forty five cents (\$2,757.45) for DII Early Education 100-243, under Education, nine hundred eighty one dollars and no cents (\$981.00) for WIC 220-450, under Health and Human Services, Five hundred thousand dollars and no cents (\$500,000.00) for Community Revitalization fund grant #4-2007-13 - 270-263, ninety thousand dollars and no cents (\$90,000.00) for Community Revitalization fund grant #10-2006-10 - 270-264 under Community Development, two thousand one hundred eighty five dollars and no cents (\$2,185.00) for Tribal Ops 250-532, four thousand dollars and no cents (\$4,000.00) for PPG grant 250-573, under Natural Resources; which amends the Total Fiscal Year 2007 Tribal Operations to read Seventy nine million twenty three thousand five hundred eight dollars and sixty two cents (\$79,023,508.62), and

Section 1.02: Amendment to Section 1.03. The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes the expenditure of supplemental programmatic funds for the following:

Section 1.03: The Band Assembly hereby authorizes Commissioners to approve budgetary transfers within programs <u>up</u> to \$10,000.00 provided that the transfers are allowable under grant provisions, if applicable and that sufficient funds are available for the transfer. For transfers <u>over</u> \$10,000.00, the Band Assembly hereby authorizes the Administration Policy Board to approve budget transfers within programs of <u>up</u> to 50% of the total programs budget within a given budget line if the program is <u>under</u> \$100,000.00 and <u>up</u> to 20% if the program is \$100,000.00 or <u>greater</u>.

All funds appropriated are maximum fund amounts and shall not be exceeded.

Section 1.04 All funds appropriated for capital construction projects shall be appropriated to align with the project length so as to automatically carryover to the next fiscal year if appropriated funds remain and if the project is not completed within Fiscal Year 2007. If, for any reason, the project length runs over the contracted period for construction causing construction costs to exceed the appropriated amount, the Band Assembly must be notified so as to take appropriate action.
