Ordinance 74-08

An Ordinance of Supplemental Appropriation for Quarterly Tribal Per Capita Distributions for Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2008.

The District II Representative introduced the following Bill on the 6th day of March, 2008.

Preamble

Be it enacted by the Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for the purpose of appropriating for quarterly tribal per capita distributions for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2008.

Title I.

Section 1: Tribal Per Capita Distributions. The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes expenditures for Bonus Distributions (March 2008 – July 2008, see schedule attached) for fiscal year ending September 30, 2008.

Section 1.01: Amendment to Section 1.02. The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes the expenditures of: Eight million two hundred forty seven thousand six hundred sixty five dollars and no cents (\$8,247,665.00) for Adult distributions, Three million seven hundred ninety four thousand dollars and no cents (\$3,794,000.00) for Minor distributions, Seven thousand three hundred thirty five dollars and no cents (\$7,335.00) for Administrative expenses, under **Bonus Distribution**; which amends the **Total Fiscal Year 2008 Tribal Distributions** to read Twenty five million two hundred seventy nine thousand dollars and no cents (\$25,279,000.00); and

Section 1.02: The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes the expenditure of supplemental funds for the following:
