

Ordinance 25-10

An Ordinance of Supplemental Appropriation for the Department of Justice of the Mille Lacs Band Tribal Government for Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2010.

The District I Representative introduced the following Bill on the 19th day of March, 2010.

Preamble

It is enacted by the Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for the purpose of appropriating for Governmental Operations for Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2010.

Title I.

Section 1: Governmental Operations. The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes expenditures for the Department of Justice of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2010.

Section 1.01: Amendment to Section 1.02: Fifteen thousand dollars and no cents (\$15,000.00) 100-175 Hazard Mitigation reimbursement through the state under **Department of Justice** which amends the **Total Fiscal Year 2010 Tribal Operations** to read: Ninety four million three hundred fifteen thousand two hundred eighty four dollars and forty five cents (\$94,315,284.45); and

Section 1.02: The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes the expenditure of supplemental programmatic funds for the following:

All funds appropriated are maximum fund amounts and shall not be exceeded.

Section 1.04: All funds appropriated for federal, state and private grant funds shall be appropriated to align with the grant terms so as to automatically carry-over to the next fiscal year if appropriated funds remain and if the grant is not completed within Fiscal Year 2010. In addition, Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes the expenditure of all federal, state and private grant funds only after receipt by Band Assembly, of signed award letter from grantor agency.


