Ordinance 56-12

An Ordinance of Supplemental Appropriation for April 2012 and May 2012 Tribal Per Capita Distributions for Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2012.

The District II Representative introduced the following Bill on the 27th day of March, 2012.

Preamble

It is enacted by the Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for the purpose of appropriating for April 2012 and May 2012 Tribal Per Capita Distribution for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012.

Title I.

Section 1: Tribal Per Capita Distributions. The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes expenditures for Bonus Distributions (April 2012 and May 2012, see schedule attached) for fiscal year ending September 30, 2012.

Section 1.01: Amendment to Section 1.02. The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes the expenditures of: Five million four hundred ninety two thousand five hundred seventy one dollars and no cents (\$5,492,571.00) for Adult distributions; Four million sixty thousand dollars and no cents (\$4,060,000.00) for Minors; Twenty five thousand dollars and no cents (\$25,000.00) for Administration costs under **Bonus Distribution**; which amends the **Total Fiscal Year 2012 Tribal Distributions** to read Thirty four million six hundred twelve thousand one hundred forty four dollars and no cents (\$34,612,144.00).

Section 1.02: The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes the expenditure of supplemental funds for the following:
