

## Ordinance 26-13

An Ordinance of Supplemental Appropriation for Economic Development for Eddy's Resort predevelopment plan of the Mille Lacs Band Tribal Government for Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2013.

The District I Representative introduced the following Bill on the 3rd day of April, 2013.

### Preamble

It is enacted by the Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for the purpose of appropriating for Economic Development of Eddy's Resort predevelopment plan for the Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2013.

### Title I

Section 1: Governmental Operations. The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes expenditures for Economic Development for Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2013.

Section 1.01: Amendment to Section 1.02. The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes the expenditures of: Nine hundred ninety nine thousand five hundred dollars and no cents (\$999,500.00) for Eddy's Resort predevelopment plan under **Economic Development of the Corporate Commission** which amends the **Total Fiscal Year 2013 Economic Development** to read: Twenty five million four hundred forty two thousand six hundred twenty three dollars and no cents (\$25,442,623.00); and

Section 1.02: The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes the expenditure of supplemental programmatic funds for the following:


