Ordinance 24-14

An Ordinance of Supplemental Appropriation for Judicial of the Mille Lacs Band Tribal Government for Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2014.

The District III Representative introduced the following Bill on the 11th day of March, 2014.

Preamble

It is enacted by the Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for the purpose of appropriating for Judicial for the Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2014.

Title I

Section 1: Governmental Operations. The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes expenditures for Judicial for the Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2014.

Section 1.01: Amendment to Section 1.02. The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes the expenditure of: Eight hundred eighteen dollars and no cents (\$818.00) to purchase (2) deluxe office chairs and a Polycom Teleconference under **Judicial** which amends the **Total Fiscal Year 2014 Mille Lacs Band Tribal Operations** to read: One hundred nineteen million one hundred fifty three thousand five hundred eighty three dollars and sixty cents (\$119,153,583.60); and

Section 1.02: The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes the expenditure of supplemental programmatic funds for the following:

Section 1.03: The Band Assembly hereby authorizes Commissioners to approve budgetary revisions within programs up to \$10,000.00 provided that the revisions are allowable under grant provisions, if applicable and that sufficient funds are available for the revision. For revisions over \$10,000.00, the Band Assembly hereby authorizes the Administration Policy Board to approve budget revisions within programs of up to 50% of the total programs budget within a given budget line if the program is under \$100,000.00 and up to 20% if the program is \$100,000.00 or greater.

Section 1.04: All funds appropriated for federal, state and private grant funds shall be appropriated to align with the grant term so as to automatically carry-over to the next Fiscal Year if appropriated funds remain and if the grant is not completed within Fiscal Year 2014. If, for any reason, the grant term runs over the original end date causing costs to exceed the original appropriated amount, the Band Assembly must be notified so as to take appropriate action. In addition, Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes the expenditure of all federal, state and private grant funds only after receipt by Band Assembly, of signed award letter from grantor agency.

All funds appropriated are maximum fund amounts and shall not be exceeded.

Dear Division of Tribal Justice:

The Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe respectfully requests \$15,528.00 in one-time funding to support immediate operating needs of the Tribal Court system.

The Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe (MLBO), a member of the federally recognized Minnesota Chippewa Tribe, is located in east central Minnesota. The MLBO reservation spans 160 non-contiguous rural miles and overlaps the counties of Aitkin, Crow Wing, Kanabec, Mille Lacs, and Pine. These non-contiguous lands comprise over 50 square miles throughout the entire MLBO service area. According to the most recent enrollment survey, MLBO's total population is 4,348 members, and 2,470 members reside within the MLBO reservation and its jurisdiction. However, all MLBO members are eligible to receive public services, including education, health and behavioral health services, legal assistance, workforce development training, and public housing assistance.

The MLBO Tribal Court has identified the following four priorities to enhance operations and safeguard effective practices in accordance with Mille Lacs Band statutes. These items are provided below in the order of highest importance:

1) Vehicle Purchase \$14,300.00

Dorbad

Tribal Court requests \$14,300 to purchase a vehicle such as the Ford Fusion. This vehicle would be shared between two court staff personnel: Process Server/Bailiff and Peacemaker. The need for such a vehicle would ensure that service is perfected when a new case is filed and notices are sent to the parties or when our Tribal Codes dictate service must be completed. Additionally, the vehicle would also be used after hours by the Peacemaker when he meets with the parties to provide peacemaking/mediation services since most prefer to meet after normal working hours. Currently, the court does not have a vehicle to provide this service and expect the staff to use their own vehicles. The attachment is an example of a vehicle that is cost effective and has good gas mileage. 2010 Ford Fusion total price is \$14,300 which is a cost estimate from Mills Auto.
