Ordinance 17-14

An Ordinance of Supplemental Appropriation for February and March 2014 Tribal Per Capita Distributions for Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2014.

The District I Representative introduced the following Bill on the 23rd day of January, 2014.

Preamble

It is enacted by the Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for the purpose of appropriating for February and March 2014 Tribal Per Capita Distribution for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2014.

Title I.

Section 1: Tribal Per Capita Distributions. The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes expenditures for Bonus Distributions (February and January 2014, see schedule attached) and Legislative/Office of Management and Budget for fiscal year ending September 30, 2014.

Section 1.01: Amendment to Section 1.02. The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes the expenditures of: Five million three hundred forty nine thousand eight hundred twenty two dollars and no cents (\$5,349,822.00) for Adult distributions 100-198-6668; Ten thousand dollars and no cents (\$10,000.00) for Admin costs 100-198-4450; (February and March 2014) under **Bonus Distribution** which amends the **Total Fiscal Year 2014 Tribal Distributions** to read: Twenty one million one hundred twenty nine thousand three hundred seventy three dollars and no cents (\$21,129,373.00); and

Section 1.02: The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes the expenditure of supplemental funds for the following:
