Ordinance 45-14

An Ordinance to amend Mille Lacs Band Statute, §501(b) of Title 18 – Commercial Practices, pursuant to legislative process articulated in 3 MLBSA §16.

The District I Representative introduced the following bill on the 30th day of September, 2014.

Preamble

It is enacted by the Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for the purpose of amending the minimum wage standards for workers within the territorial jurisdiction of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe.

Minimum Wage Amendment

The Band Assembly amends §501(b) to read in its entirety as follows:

Except as may otherwise be provided for in this Chapter, the Band and every Large Employer must pay wages to each employee in the minimum amount of \$8.50 per hour unless a higher amount is required under applicable law.

The above amendment to 18 MLBSA §501(b) shall become effective upon signature approval, or non-action, by the Chief Executive in accordance with 3 MLBSA §16(c).
