

Ordinance 50-15

An Ordinance of Supplemental Appropriation for Adult Band Member Supplemental Economic Payments from Unspent Net Revenue for Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2015.

The District III Representative introduced the following Bill on the 13th day of August, 2015.

Preamble

It is enacted by the Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for the purpose of appropriating from Unspent Net Revenue for Adult Band Member Supplemental Economic Payments for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2015.

Title I.

Section 1: Unspent Net Revenue: Adult Band Member Supplemental Economic Payments. The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes expenditures for Adult Band Member Economic Supplemental Payments, from Unspent Net Revenue, for Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2015.

Section 1.01: Amendment to Section 1.02. The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes the expenditures of Unspent Net Revenue of: Three million one hundred fifty five thousand dollars and no cents (\$3,155,000.00) for Adult Band Members \$1,000 each (18 years and older, effective August 21, 2015) Supplemental Economic Payments, under **Unspent Net Revenue**; which amends the **Total Fiscal Year 2015 Unspent/Net Revenue** to read: Forty one million five hundred thirty two thousand eight hundred dollars and twenty two cents (\$41,532,800.22); and

Section 1.02: The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes the expenditure of supplemental funds for the following:

Supplemental Economic Distribution Of Unspent/Net Revenue For Adults at \$1,000 each (18 years and older, effective August 21, 2015)	\$3,155,000.00	\$41,532,800.22

All funds appropriated are maximum fund amounts and shall not be exceeded.
