Ordinance 16-15

An Ordinance of Supplemental Appropriation for reimbursement of Gaming Economic Development purchase of D2 Anderson property from Permanent Initiative of the Mille Lacs Band Tribal Government for Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2015.

The District III Representative introduced the following Bill on the 12th day of February, 2015.

Preamble

It is enacted by the Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for the purpose of appropriating for Permanent Initiative for the Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2015.

Title I

Section 1: Governmental Operations. The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes expenditures from Permanent Initiative for the Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2015.

Section 1.01: Amendment to Section 1.02. The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes the expenditure of: Three hundred three thousand five hundred ninety four dollars and eighty four cents (\$303,594.84) for reimbursement of Gaming Economic Development funds for the purchase of the D2 Anderson property; under **Permanent Initiative** which amends the **Total Fiscal Year 2015 Permanent Initiative** to read: Eight million nine hundred ninety thousand nine hundred three dollars and seventeen cents (\$8,990,903.17); and

Section 1.02: The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes the expenditure of supplemental programmatic funds for the following:
