

Ordinance 14-15

An Ordinance of Supplemental Appropriation from the Gaming Economic Development Fund for the purchase of the Meleen’s property in Onamia, Minnesota for Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2015.

The District I Representative introduced the following Bill on the 5th day of February, 2015.

Preamble

It is enacted by the Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for the purpose of appropriating for the purchase of the Meleen’s property in Onamia, Minnesota for the Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2015.

Title I

Section 1: Economic Development. The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes expenditures from the Gaming Economic Development Fund for Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2015.

Section 1.01: Amendment to Section 1.02. The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes the expenditures of: One million fifty three thousand five hundred and no cents (\$1,053,500.00) for the purchase of Meleen’s property under the **Gaming Economic Development Fund**, which amends the **Total Fiscal Year 2015 Gaming Economic Development Fund** to read: Eight million Five hundred fifty nine thousand eight hundred ninety eight dollars and no cents (\$8,559,898.00).

Section 1.02: Amendment to Section 1.03. The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes the expenditure of supplemental programmatic funds for the following:



All funds appropriated shall stay within the given budgeted amounts and the Corporate Commission shall update the Band Assembly on the formal close-out process. All unspent funds appropriated shall be returned to the Mille Lacs Band no later than sixty days for Meleen’s Property.

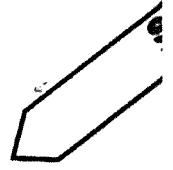
