Ordinance 19-16

An Ordinance of Supplemental Appropriation and Budget Transfer/Modification for the Education, Natural Resources, Health & Human Services, Community Development and Administration Departments for the Fiscal Years ending September 30, 2015 and September 30, 2016.

The District I Representative introduced the following Bill on the 4th day of February, 2016.

Preamble

It is enacted by the Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for the purpose of appropriating and authorizing a budget transfer for the Education, Natural Resources, Health & Human Services, Community Development and Administration Departments for the Fiscal Years ending September 30, 2015 and September 30, 2016.

Title I

Section 1: Governmental Operations. The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes expenditures and a budget transfer for the Education, Natural Resources, Health & Human Services, Community Development and Administration Departments for the Fiscal Years ending September 30, 2015 and September 30, 2016.

Section 1.01: Amendment to Section 1.02. The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes the expenditure of: Forty-seven thousand nine hundred seventy dollars and no cents (\$47,970.00) for NASS Transportation 201-326 of FY16 Unspent/Net Revenue Funds to complete the purchase of the second bus approved for but not received before the end of the fiscal year 2015; Forty-six thousand three hundred dollars and no cents (\$46,300.00) for 21st Century Learning Center 201-334 of BIE Funds to be used for salary, fringe, supplies and transportation costs under Education; Two hundred forty-five thousand dollars and no cents (\$245,000.00) for Real Estate 250-595 of FY16 Permanent Initiative Funds to support a commercial land acquisition located at 800 Highway 47 S Isle, MN; Twenty-three thousand dollars and no cents (\$23,000.00) for Circle of Flight 250-536 of FY16 BIA Grant Funds to be utilized to create nesting structures for the Common Tern, a species that is co-managed between the Mille Lacs Band & the United States Fish & Wildlife Service; Seventeen thousand ninetyone dollars and no cents (\$17,091.00) for Air Quality 250-541 of FY16 Grant Funds to be used for salary and fringe benefits under Natural Resources; Thirty-one thousand dollars and no cents (\$31,000.00) for MN Dept Corrections 220-453 of FY16 Unspent/Net Revenue Funds for grant match which didn't carryover and follow the grant extension at the end of fiscal year 2015; Eighty thousand two hundred seventy-six dollars and no cents (\$80,276.00) for MDH Tobacco 220-481 of FY16 Grant Funds; Ninety-five thousand two hundred seventy-six dollars and no cents (\$95,276.00) for SHIP Grant 220-410 of FY16 Grant Funds; Seventy-five thousand dollars and no cents (\$75,000.00) for MCT Snap Ed 220-408 of FY16 Grant Funds; Ninety-three thousand five hundred dollars and no cents (\$93,500.00) for Wraparound 220-New of FY16 Grant Funds to hire a Wraparound Facilitator position to directly case manage homelessness for the Mille Lacs Band under Health & Human Services; Fifty thousand eight hundred ninetythree dollars and thirty-six cents (\$50,893.36) for IHS 100-126 of FY15 Carryover Unspent/Net Revenue Funds for the Bands match on an IHS Grant; Twenty-one thousand two hundred eighty dollars and no cents (\$21,280.00) for Powwow Committee 100-107 of FY16 Permanent Initiative Funds for electrical upgrades at the DI Powwow grounds; Seven million eight hundred fifty-one thousand five hundred seventy-nine dollars and thirty-eight cents (\$7,851,579.38) for Housing Initiative 100-235 of FY15 Carryover Housing Initiative Funds for the contract commitment amounts of ongoing projects as of 9/30/15; Two hundred three thousand three hundred seventy-one dollars and no cents (\$203,371.00) for Earthworks 100-131 of FY16 Permanent Initiative Funds to support capital equipment purchase of a Caterpillar Bulldozer for the Earthworks Department; Eight hundred ninety-one thousand nine hundred sixty-seven dollars and seventy-four cents (\$891,967.74) for Immersion Building Construction Budget 320-000 of FY15 Carryover Permanent Initiative Funds for contract obligations, furnish the offices and sleeping, kitchen equipment, and black dirt and class 5 for the yard and driveway under Community Development which amends the Total Fiscal Year 2016 Mille Lacs Band Tribal Operations to read: Eighty-five million seven hundred eighteen thousand five hundred eighteen dollars and forty-eight cents (\$85,718,518.48); and

Section 1.03: The Band Assembly hereby authorizes Commissioners to approve budgetary revisions within programs <u>up</u> to \$10,000.00 provided that the revisions are allowable under grant provisions, if applicable and that sufficient funds are available for the revision. For revisions <u>over</u> \$10,000.00, the Band Assembly hereby authorizes the Administration Policy Board to approve budget revisions within programs of <u>up</u> to 50% of the total program's budget within a given budget line if the program is <u>under</u> \$100,000.00 and <u>up</u> to 20% if the program is \$100,000.00 or greater.

Section 1.04: All funds appropriated for federal, state and private grant funds shall be appropriated to align with the grant term so as to automatically carry-over to the next Fiscal Year if appropriated funds remain and if the grant is not completed within Fiscal Year 2016. If, for any reason, the grant term runs over the original end date causing costs to exceed the original appropriated amount, the Band Assembly must be notified so as to take appropriate action. In addition, Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes the expenditure of all federal, state and private grant funds only after receipt by Band Assembly, of signed award letter from grantor agency.

All funds appropriated are maximum fund amounts and shall not be exceeded.
