## Ordinance 22-17

The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes the expenditure of: Twenty-four thousand two hundred sixty-nine dollars and no cents (\$24,269.00) for Tribal Court 100-150 of FY17 Unspent/Net Revenue Funds for the purchase of equipment and installation costs for the Bailiff's vehicle that will also allow him to be equipped to handle duties on the road as a licensed Police Officer under **Judicial** which amends the **Total Fiscal Year 2017 Mille Lacs Band Tribal Operations** to read: Two hundred six million seven hundred sixty-nine thousand three hundred twelve dollars and twenty-five cents (\$206,769,312.25).
