### Ordinance 50-17

An Ordinance of Supplemental Appropriation for the Health & Human Services, and Natural Resources Departments for the Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2017.

### Preamble

It is enacted by the Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for the purpose of appropriating and authorizing expenditures for the Health & Human Services, and Natural Resources Departments for the Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2017.

### Title I
