### Ordinance 14-17

The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes the expenditures of: Six million seven hundred fifty-six thousand three hundred fifty-two dollars and no cents (\$6,756,352.00) for Clinic Building 330-000 of FY17 Unspent/Net Revenue Funds for updated commercial construction costs of the D1 Health & Human Services building as submitted under **Health & Human Services** which amends the **Total Fiscal Year 2017 Mille Lacs Band Tribal Operations** to read: One hundred sixty-eight million eighty-nine thousand fifty-seven dollars and forty-two cents (\$168,089,057.42).
