# Ordinance 20-18

An Ordinance of Supplemental Appropriation for the Department of Justice for the Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2018.

# Preamble

It is enacted by the Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for the purpose of appropriating and authorizing expenditure for the Department of Justice for the Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2018.

### Title I

Section 1: Governmental Operations. The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes expenditure for the Department of Justice for the Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2018.

Section 1.01: Amendment to Section 1.02. The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes the expenditures of: Two hundred ten thousand dollars and no cents (\$210,000.00) for Legal Services 5100-100-2150-0 of FY18 Unspent/Net Revenue Funds to cover the costs associated with Zionts Chestnut biennial contract in which the firm is engaged in parallel litigation and mediation efforts on behalf of the Band under **Department of Justice** which amends the **Total Fiscal Year 2018 Mille Lacs Band Tribal Operations** to read: Two hundred five million sixty-four thousand five hundred eight dollars and twenty-seven cents (\$205,064,508.27).

Section 1.02: The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes the expenditures of supplemental programmatic funds for the following:
