Dear Honorable Members of the Band Assembly:

Pursuant to 4 MLBSA § 6(1), I veto Band Assembly Bill 19-03-22-21, a bill to establish the Advisory Committee to the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Foundation.

First, I believe it is important for the proposed law to contain a provision limiting the length of time that the elected officials serve as members of the advisory committee. After participating in a Joint Session of the Band Assembly to discuss a course of action regarding the advisory committee, it was my understanding that the Band Assembly would pass a bill temporarily establishing the elected officials as the advisory committee until it establishes a permanent and nonpartisan advisory committee consisting of non-elected officials in order to make recommendations on pending applications.

Second, I also believe that the Chief Executive should serve as the advisory committee's Vice-Chairperson in order to advance division of powers principles.

I look forward to discussing this issue further at our compromise hearing and I am confident that we can quickly resolve this issue. Please contact me if you would like to discuss this further prior to the compromise hearing.
