

Ordinance 63-21

An Ordinance of Supplemental Appropriation for the September 2021 Tribal General Welfare Assistance Program for the Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2021. This bill has been drafted based on formal documents submitted by the Office of Management and Budget on August 17, 2021.

The District I Representative introduced the following Bill on the 18th day of August, 2021.

IT IS ENACTED BY THE BAND ASSEMBLY OF THE NON-REMOVABLE MILLE LACS BAND OF OJIBWE:

Section 1: Governmental operations. The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes expenditures for the Legislative Branch for the Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2021.

Section 1.01: Appropriation and authorizations of expenditures. The Band Assembly hereby appropriates and authorizes the expenditures of supplemental programmatic funds for the following:
