

Commissioner's Order 15-85

Corporate Affairs

A Commissioner's Order to issue a temporary gaming license.

WHEREAS, under provisions of Band Statute 1032-MLC-1, Section 28, addition of Section 7.03, the Commissioner of Corporate Affairs shall have sole authority to administer, regulate and authorize all business enterprises under the jurisdiction of the Band, and;

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Corporate Affairs shall have the power to authorize, organize and reorganize all business related matters in the interest of increased economic development, and;

WHEREAS, Kathio Charitable Gaming Foundation and the Elderly Committee License for the selling of Pull Tabs, Conducting Raffles, and Conducting Bingo games, has expired on June 30, 1985, and;

WHEREAS, in the temporary absence of Corporate Commission, due to expired terms and resignations.


