## Corporate Affairs

A Commissioner's Order to permit operations at the Marina and Drift Inn, pending successful contract negotiations.

- WHEREAS, under provisions of Band Statute 1001-MLC-1, Section 28, addition of Section 7.03. The Commissioner of Corporate Affairs shall have sole authority to administer, regulate and authorize all business enterprises under the jurisdiction of the Band, and;
- WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Corporate Affairs shall have the power to authorize, organize and reorganize all business related matters in the interest of increased economic development, and;
- WHEREAS: Gene Reynolds at the Drift Inn and Georgianna B. Day at the Marina Complex do not have a valid lease approved by the Commissioner of Corporate Affairs: Chief Executive and the Band Assembly. Both are participating in lease negotiations.
- NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me pursuant by Band Statute 1001-MLC-1, Section 28, I, Lew Boyd, do hereby order that Gene Reynolds of the Drift Inn and Georgianna B. Day of the Marina Complex be authorized to continue to operate each entity until July 20, 1984, 12:00 noon.
- BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that negotiations be finalized and approve by the Chief Executive and Band Assembly no later than July 20, 1984, 12:00 noon.
