

COMMISSIONER'S ORDER 18-86

CORPORATE AFFAIRS

A commissioner's order to enact personnel guidelines governing Kathio Charitable Gaming Foundation, pending the completion and formal adoption of said operations personnel policies.

WHEREAS, under provisions of Band Statute 1001-MLC-1, Section 28, addition of Section 7.03. The commissioner of Corporate Affairs shall have sole authority to administer, regulate and authorize all business enterprises under the jurisdiction of the Band, and;

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Corporate Affairs shall have the power to authorize, organize and reorganize all business related matters in the interest of increased economic development, and;

WHEREAS, Kathio Charitable Gaming Foundation has developed the need to adopt independent personal policies to govern its specific operation.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Band Statute 1001-MLC-1, Section 28, I, Martin Jennings, Commissioner of Corporate Affairs do hereby order that all domestic/foreign enterprises, and non-profit organizations currently operating under jurisdiction of the Non-Removable Band of Mille Lacs Chippewa Indians to file applications for Operating Licenses or permits for fiscal year 1986 with the Corporate Commissioner by February 13, 1986.

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that noncompliance of order 18-86 shall cause said business or organization to be closed down due to lapse of operating license.


