
COMMISSIONER'S ORDER 18-86

CORPORATE AFFAIRS

A commissioner's order to enact personnel guidelines governing Kathio Charitable Gaming Foundation, pending the completion and formal adoption of said operations personnel policies.

- WHEREAS, under provisions of Band Statute 1001-MLC-1, Section 28, addition of Section 7.03. The commissioner of Corporate Affairs shall have sole authority to administer, regulate and authorize all business enterprises under the jurisdiction of the Band, and;
- WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Corporate Affairs shall have the power to authorize, organize and reorganize all business related matters in the interest of increased economic development, and;
- WHEREAS, Kathio Charitable Gaming Foundation has developed the need to adopt independent personnal policies to govern its specific operation.
- NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Band Statute 1001-MLC-1, Section 28, I, Martin Jennings, Commissioner of Corporate Affairs do hereby order that all domestic/foreign enterprises, and non-profit organizations currently operating under jurisdication of the Non-Removable Band of Mille Lacs Chippewa Indians to file applications for Operating Licenses or permits for fiscal year 1986 with the Corporate Commissioner by February 13, 1986.
- BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that noncompliance of order 18-86 shall cause said business or organization to be closed down due to lapse of operating license.
