

COMMISSIONER'S ORDER 20 -86

CORPORATE AFFAIRS

A Commissioner's Order to repeal Commissioner's Order 18-86 due to technical unclarity.

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Band Statute 1032-MLC-1, Section 28, the Commissioner of Corporate Affairs shall have the sole authority to administer, regulate and authorize all business enterprises under the jurisdiction of the Band, and;

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Corporate Affairs shall have the power to authorize, organize and reorganize all business related matters in the interest of increased economic development, and;

WHEREAS, Commissioner's Order 18-86 is unclear as to its intent and general purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Band Statute 1032-MLC-1, Section 28, I, Martin Jennings, Commissioner of Corporate Affairs do hereby order that Commissioner's Order 18-86 be repealed.


