A Commissioner's Order to Issue a Temporary Gaming License

WHEREAS, under provisions of Band Statute 1001-MLC-1, Section 28, addition of Section 7.03, the Commissioner of Corporate Affairs shall have sole authority to administer, regulate and authorize all business enterprises under the jurisdiction of the Band, and;

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Corporate Affairs shall have the power to authorize, organize and reorganize all business related matters in the interest of increased economic development, and;

WHEREAS, Nay-Ah-Shing Boxing Club has applied for a license to conduct Raffles and the Selling of Pull Tabs, and;

WHEREAS, In the temporary absence of a Corporate Commissioner, due to expired terms and resignations.


