

COMMISSIONERS ORDER 33-89

A COMMISSIONER'S ORDER TO TEMPORARILY FUND DEANNA SAM UNDER A.N.A. PROJECT SOURCES UNTIL DEMONSTRATION PROJECT FUNDS BECOME AVAILABLE.

WHEREAS, each Commissioner shall take such measures as are necessary to prevent any action which threatens the well being of programs, and/or Band members, under Band Statute 1032-MLC-1, Section 25; and

WHEREAS, Deanna Sam has been employed and compensated under the Demonstration Project providing various office/secretarial services for this project; and

WHEREAS, current sources of funding utilized for the Demonstration Project have been depleted; and

WHEREAS, at present an alternative source of funds has been identified under A.N.A. Project to continue to employ said employee; and

WHEREAS the Assistant Commissioner of Administration is authorized under Band Statute 1032-MLC-1, Section 27, to issue an order pursuant to his lawful duty.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Assistant Commissioner of Administration I, Raymond Kegg, do hereby order that Deanna Sam be transferred from the Demonstration Project to A.N.A. Project at the same capacity and rate of compensation for the purposes of funding her position beginning April 3, 1989.

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the cost of this employment position shall be reimbursed when the new Demonstration Project funds are received back to the A.N.A. Project.

BE IT FURTHER AND FINALLY ORDERED, that at the time the new Demonstration Project funds are received that said employee be reinstated back to original project.
