Project at the same capacity and rate of compensation for the purposes of funding her position beginning April 3,1989.
- BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the cost of this employment position shall be reimbursed when the new Demonstration Project funds are received back to the A.N.A. Project.
- BE IT FURTHER AND FINALLY ORDERED, that at the time the new Demonstration Project funds are received that said employee be reinstated back to original project.
