

COMMISSIONER'S ORDER 25-86
ADMINISTRATION

A Commissioner's Order to establish procedures for implementation of a cooperative effort regarding the MEED Program, between the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians {MLBCI} and the Arrowhead Economic Opportunity Agency {AEOA} of Virginia, Minnesota.

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Administration has the authority to issue a Commissioner's Order necessary in the performance of his lawful duty, and;

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Administration has determined that it would serve the MLBCI to enter into a cooperative effort with the AEOA to extend MEED programmatic benefits to the MLBCI, and;

WHEREAS, the MLBCI, through the actions of the Commissioner of Administration; and the AEOA, through its Manpower Specialist and his subordinate employees; have agreed to enter into a cooperative effort to implement a MEED program for mutual interests.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Band Statute 1032-MLC-1, Section 27 and Section 25, I, David Aubid, Commissioner of Administration do hereby order that the following procedures be established for said implementation of cooperative agreement.

BE IT ORDERED, that the creation of MEED positions be made available to assigned worksites on the reservation through this cooperative agreement with the following categories;

- a. LPN - 1
- b. Clerical workers - 3
- c. Natural Resources Planners - 2
- d. Natural Resources Developer - 1
- e. Building and Maintenance Managers {public {3} and corporate {1} facilities}

BE IT ORDERED, that the MEED job applicants position categories be hired according to the following criteria;

- a. LPN {1} MEED eligible
 - LPN licensure
 - Valid Drivers license - {No DWI, No DAR}
 - Previous employment records
- b. Clerical workers {3}
 - MEED eligible
 - High School diploma or equivalent
 - Office related previous employment
 - Certified office skills training
 - Typing skill of at least 35 words per minute
 - Residents of Mille Lacs County
- c. Natural Resource Planners {2}
 - MEED eligible
 - Valid Drivers license - {No DWI, No DAR}
 - High School diploma or equivalent
 - Previous related employment experience

- 1 Resident of Aitkin County
- 1 Resident of Pine County
- d. Natural Resource Fishery Developer {1}
 - MEED eligible
 - Previous experience building fish traps
 - Knowledge of working with rough fish
 - Willingness to work on weekends
 - Physical ability to carry 50 pounds at least ten yards
- e. Building and Maintenance Managers {4}
 - {Public and Corporate facilities}
 - MEED eligible
 - High School diploma or equivalent
 - Previous experience in work related field
 - Valid Drivers license - {No DWI, No DAR}

BE IT ORDERED, that pursuant to Band Statute 1085-MLC-3b, Section 54, Indian Employment Rights Law shall apply to these positions.

BE IT ORDERED, that MEED position announcements be displayed in areas where MLBCI employees work on the Reservation, and said announcements be closed at 12:00 Noon, February 6, 1986.

BE IT ORDERED, that AEOA issued MEED applications to be distributed and collected by the Executive Secretary and JTPA Coordinator.

BE IT FURTHER AND FINALLY ORDERED, that all applicants for MEED positions shall be selected for employment at the Band worksites on the sole basis of their ability to meet the aforementioned criteria.
