

Commissioner's Order 17-84

Administration

A Commissioner's Order granting a two month extension to comply with Section 5.04 of Personnel Policy Section.

WHEREAS, the Personnel Policies of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians states pursuant to Section 5.04 "All vacation leave should be used before the end of the program year;" and,

WHEREAS, a substantial number of employees failed to realize that annual leave shall not be carried forward to a new fiscal year without substantial penalty; and,

WHEREAS, to grant annual leave to all employees for the balance of the month of September would jeopardize the normal delivery of services to Band members.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Band Statute 1032-MLC-1, Section 25, I, Raymond Kegg, Assistant Commissioner of Administration do hereby order a two month extension to November 30, 1984 to permit annual leave to be taken without penalty of for future.


BE IT FURTHER AND FINALLY ORDERED, that Contracting Officers shall schedule annual leave in accordance as not to disrupt governmental functions and shall be held accountable to order annual leave for employees who fail to take annual leave at an opportune time as to avoid disruption in governmental service to the people.
