

Commissioner's Order 16 - 84

Administration

A Commissioner's Order to hold a policy board subject-matter hearing on the Ah Shu Moog Project.

WHEREAS: "Each Commissioner shall take care for the governments business" under Band Statute 1032-MLC-1, Section 25; and;

WHEREAS: Each Commissioner shall take such measures as are necessary to prevent any impending action which threatens the well being of programs; legal system; natural resource; businesses; and/or band members; {emphasis added} under Band Statute 1032-MLC-1, Section 25; and;

WHEREAS: "Each Commissioner shall have the power to hold policy board subject-matter hearings and be possessed of the power of Courts of tribal law, to issue subpoenas and cause them to be served and enforced" under Band Statute 1032-MLC-1, Section 25; and;

WHEREAS: the Commissioner of Administration is authorized under Band Statute 1032-MLC-1, Section 27, to issue an order pursuant to his lawful duty; and;

WHEREAS: the Commissioner of Administration feels that the Ah Shu Moog Project has reached a point which threatens its {present and future} well being.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Commissioner of Administration, I, David Aubid, do hereby order that a policy board subject-matter hearing on the Ah Shu Moog convene September 5, 1984 at 10:00 in the conference room at the Mille Lacs Band Government Center. Said hearing shall be completed no later than 4:00 p.m. September 13, 1984.

BE IT FURTHER AND FINALLY ORDERED: that Raymond Kegg is hereby assigned responsibility for implementation that the appearance of conflict of interest by the Commissioner of Administration is removed.


