Commissioner's Order 57-94

A COMMISSIONER'S ORDER LIFTING THE REQUIREMENT THAT ALL BAND EMPLOYEES EXPEND ALL ANNUAL LEAVE EFFECTIVE MARCH 1, 1994.

- WHEREAS, pursuant to Mille Lacs Band Statute 1142-MLC-3, Section 8.04, the Commissioner of Administration has the authority to regulate the performance of their duties by all persons employed for the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, and:
- WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Band to provide fringe benefits to its employees, and:
- WHEREAS, because of work schedules, some employees are unable to utilize their annual leave and have accumulated hours, and;
- WHEREAS, an employee who has accumulated annual leave should not be penalized, and:
- WHEREAS, a policy is being implemented by Administration to address the annual leave of all employees.
- NOW THEREFORE, be it ordered that no employee shall lose accumulated annual leave if that employee has a balance as of March 1, 1994, for fiscal year 1994.
