Commissioner's Order 57-91

A COMMISSIONER'S ORDER LIFTING THE REQUIREMENT THAT ALL BAND EMPLOYEES EXPEND ALL ANNUAL LEAVE EFFECTIVE MARCH 1, 1994.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Mille Lacs Band Statute 1142-MLC-3, Section 8.04, the Commissioner of Administration has the authority to regulate the performance of their duties by all persons employed for the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, and;

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Band to provide fringe benefits to its employees, and;


WHEREAS, because of work schedules, some employees are unable to utilize their annual leave and have accumulated hours, and;

WHEREAS, an employee who has accumulated annual leave should not be penalized, and;


WHEREAS, a policy is being implemented by Administration to address the annual leave of all employees.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordered that no employee shall lose accumulated annual leave if that employee has a balance as of March 1, 1994, for fiscal year 1994.
