Commissioner's Order 041-99

A COMMISSIONER'S ORDER TO ESTABLISH A BUILDING CODE FOR THE MILLE LACS BAND OF OJIBWE INDIANS

- WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance 20-97 Chapter 2 § 4 the Commissioner of Community Development has the authority to inspect and ensure the safety of all buildings and facilities within the jurisdiction of the Mille Lacs Band and to condemn the same when appropriate; and,
- WHEREAS, pursuant to 4 MLBSA § 7(h) the Commissioner of Community Development is authorized to issue Commissioner's Orders on any subject matter within his area of subject matter jurisdiction; and,
- WHEREAS, pursuant to Mille Lacs Band Statue 4 MLBSA § 7(i), the Commissioner of Community Development is authorized to take such measures as are deemed necessary to prevent any action which threatens the well-being of programs within his area of subject matter jurisdiction by issuance of a Commissioner's Order; and.
- WHEREAS, it is necessary to adopt a building code to provide basic uniform minimum construction standards, establish reasonable safeguards for the health, safety, welfare, comfort, and security of the residents of Mille Lacs Reservation and provide for the use of modern methods, devices, materials, and techniques which should help lower construction costs.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered that the Uniform Building Code issued by the International Conference of Building Officials Volume I, Volume II. Volume III published in April 1997 is hereby adopted as the Building Code of the Band. All Construction on the reservation shall meet the standards contained in this building code.
