WHEREAS, under provisions of Band Statute 1001-MLC-1 Section 7, the Commissioner of Education has the authority to take such measures as are necessary to prevent any actions which threaten the well being of Educational Programs; and,


WHEREAS, the Educational Administration has received jurisdiction over a new program entitled Ah-Shu-Moog and said program staff have not been officially hired; and,

WHEREAS, said program is operational under terms and conditions listed in the contract with the State of Minnesota.


