

Commissioner's Order 04-83

Education

A Commissioner's Order to preserve order and for the protection of educational matters related to the operation of Nay-Ah-Shing School.

WHEREAS, under provisions of Band Statute 1040-MLC-1B, Section 4, the Commissioner of Education has the authority to manage the day-to-day administrative activities of Nay-Ah-Shing School; and,


WHEREAS, the School Board for Nay-Ah-Shing School has not been confirmed by the Band Assembly for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians; and,

WHEREAS, the School Board for Nay-Ah-Shing School has the authority under Band Statute 1040-MLC-1B, Section 2 to employ personnel; and,


WHEREAS, the Nay-Ah-Shing School is in need of a principal to assist in the day to day operation of the school.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Lon Burr, under the authority vested in me by Band Statute 1040-MLC-1B, Section 4 for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, do hereby order the hiring of a principal for thirty (30) consecutive days until such time as the School Board exercises their legal authority in this matter.
