## Education

- A Commissioner's Order to preserve order and for the protection of educational matters related to the operation of Nay-Ah-Shing School.
- WHEREAS, under provisions of Band Statute 1040-MLC-18, Section 4, the Commissioner of Education has the authority to manage the day-to-day administrative activities of Nay-Ah-Shing School; and
- WHEREAS, the School Board for Nay-Ah-Shing School has not been confirmed by the Band Assembly for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians; and
- WHEREAS: the School Board for Nay-Ah-Shing School has the authority under Band Statute 1848-MLC-18: Section 2 to employ personnel; and:
- WHEREAS, the Nay-Ah-Shing School is in need of a principal to assist in the day to day operation of the school.
- NOW THEREFORE, In Lon Burn, under the authority vested in me by Band Statute 1040-ML(-18, Section 4 for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, do hereby order the hiring of a principal for thirty (30) consecutive days until such time as the School Board exercises their legal authority in this matter.
